

Delta Phi Alpha Scholarships

Spring / Summer German Study Abroad Scholarship — Deadline November 15th

Award Amounts: \$1,500 (2) \$500 (up to 5)

This study abroad scholarship supports Delta Phi Alpha Members who are planning to study abroad on an academic credit-bearing program in a German-speaking country with a start date in the first half of the calendar year. (January – June start date)

While all DPA members are encouraged to apply, committee preference will be given to programs that:

- promote the advanced use of the German language.
- have a duration of six or more weeks
- incorporate the study abroad experience into their major / career goals

Fall / Winter Semester German Study Abroad Scholarship — Deadline March 15th

Award Amounts: \$1,500 (1) \$500 (up to 4)

This study abroad scholarship supports Delta Phi Alpha Members who are planning to study abroad on an academic credit-bearing program in a German-speaking country with a start date in the second half of the calendar year. (July-December start date)

While all DPA members are encouraged to apply, committee preference will be given to programs that:

- promote the advanced use of the German language.
- have a duration of six or more weeks
- incorporate the study abroad experience into their major / career goals

Future K-12 German Teacher Award — Deadline March 15th

Award Amount: \$500 + student membership in the American Association of Teachers of German

This award is intended to recognize outstanding future K-12 teachers of German. Any Delta Phi Alpha member actively seeking certification to teach German at the K-12 level is eligible for the award. This includes students in undergraduate or graduate programs. The recipient must provide evidence that they are enrolled in a teacher certification program.

Graduate Study in German Scholarship — Deadline March 15th

Award Amount: \$1000

The Graduate Study Scholarship recognizes one graduating senior or early stage Graduate student (Entering first or second year) who demonstrated excellence in German Studies at the undergraduate level. Only Delta Phi Alpha members from active chapters are eligible for this scholarship.

This award is intended for students who are entering the first or second year of a graduate program related to German Studies at a North American university. The recipient must provide evidence that they have accepted an offer to begin an M.A. or Ph.D. program within the provided timeframe. The funds may be used by the recipient for any purpose related to graduate study.
